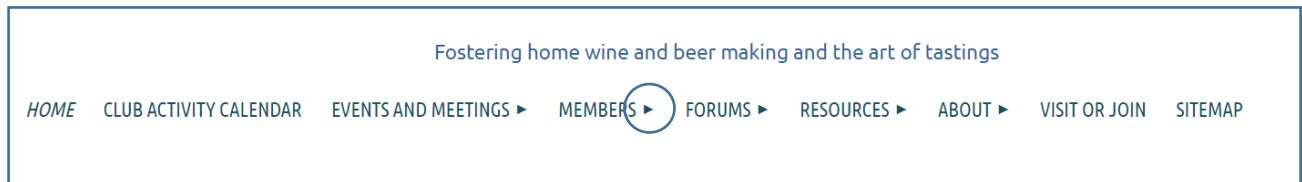
To search the website
